

The Little Friendlies 3-in-1 Baby Centre by VTech® has three ways to play and grow with your child. Watch your little one get a workout as they grab the dangling animals in the baby gym. As they grow, the gym changes into a floor activity panel and a walker with interactive activities. The gym will teach colours, numbers, shapes and animals and can play lively and soothing music!

- Two gym/walker legs
- Four colourful wheels

WARNING:

All packing materials, such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks and tags are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.

Unlock the packing locks:

- ① Rotate the packing locks 90 degrees counter-clockwise
- 2 Pull out the packing locks



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the activity panel. Use a coin or a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- 3. Install 2 new 'AA' (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product

Please ensure that the legs and activity panel are securely locked into position to avoid injury.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. TO ASSEMBLE THE BABY CENTRE

To assemble the baby centre in the GYM position, insert the activity panel on to the legs and turn the screws to secure the legs.






2. TO CONVERT THE BABY CENTRE

Release the lock on the activity panel by pressing the small button on the bottom of the main panel and loosen the screw plugs simultaneously. Then move the activity panel to the required angle and tighten the screws. The activity panel can be set at different angles for gym play, sitting play and walker play.





a). To assemble the gym position, insert the activity panel on to the legs so the activity panel is at 45 degrees or 90 degrees. Turn the screws to secure the legs. Insert the four wheels in the upper position.



b). To assemble the walker position, insert the activity panel into the legs so the activity panel is at 180 degrees. Turn the screws to secure the legs. Insert the 4 wheels into the recessed slots on the bottom of the walker legs. You will hear the wheels click into place when inserted correctly. Please check to make sure all the wheels are secure before using the walker.






3. TO DISASSEMBLE FROM GYM OR WALKER

To play with the activity panel, remove the legs and place the activity panel on the floor. Push the little button on the legs up to pull out the wheels.





PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

To turn the unit **ON**, slide the **ON**/ **OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH** to the **LOW VOLUME** ((\blacksquare)) or **HIGH VOLUME** (\blacksquare)) position. To turn the unit **OFF**, slide the **ON/OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH** to the **OFF** (\bullet) position.



2. MODE SELECTOR SWITCH

Slide the **MODE SELECTOR SWITCH** to the **LEARNING MODE** () or the **MUSIC MODE** () position to choose a mode of play.



3. MOTION SENSOR

The **MOTION SENSOR** is located inside the activity panel. When the unit is in the walker mode position, push the walker to hear fun sounds talking phrases and playful music.




4. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the **VTech® Little Friendlies 3-in-1 Baby Centre** will automatically power-down after approximately 60 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button. Moving the walker will not turn the unit back on.

ACTIVITIES

1. Slide the **on/off/volume control switch** to turn the unit on, then slide the mode selector switch to choose a mode of play. You will hear fun sounds, talking phrases and playful sing-along songs. The light will flash with the sound.



2. Press the **piano keys** to learn colours, numbers and shapes and hear piano sounds in the Learning Mode. In the Music Mode, you will hear piano notes in the walker position or long playing melodies in the gym position. When the melodies are playing, press the piano keys to play the melodies one note at a time. The light will flash with the sound.



3. Turn the **flower page** to learn animals and hear fun sing-along songs and melodies in the Learning Mode. In the Music Mode, you will hear sounds and sing-along songs in the walker position and soothing melodies in the gym position. The light will flash with the sound.



- Spin the roller ball to hear a variety of sounds in the Learning Mode and short tunes in the Music Mode. The light will flash with the sound.
- 5. Swing the **dangling animals** in the Learning Mode to hear sounds and phrases in the walker position and sounds and short tunes in the gym position. In the Music Mode, you will hear long playing playful music in the walker position and long playing soothing music in the gym position. The light will flash with the sound.
- Activate the motion sensor in the walker position to hear fun sounds, phrases and playful music. Continue moving the walker while a melody is playing to hear fun sounds play over the melody. The light will flash with the sound.

- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING


If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
