WARNING:


All packing materials such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties and packaging screws are not part of this toy and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE: Please keep user's manual as it contains important information.

NOTE: For your child's safety, do not aim at face or eyes when launching the ZoomiZooz™ animals.

Unlock the packaging locks:

- ① Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- Pull out the packaging locks.



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 2 new "AAA" (LR03/AM-4)
 batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metalhydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- · Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF/Volume Control Switch

To turn the unit ON, slide the ON/OFF/Volume Control Switch to the Low Volume (■)) or the High Volume (■)) position. You will hear a song, a phrase and a sound effect. To turn the unit OFF, slide the On/Off/Volume Control Switch to the OFF (●) position.




2. AUTOMATIC SHUT OFF

To preserve battery life, the **ZoomiZooz™ Alligator** will automatically shut-off after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button or putting a ZoomiZooz™ on the **Magic ZoomiZone**.

Note: If the unit repeatedly shuts off quickly, we suggest changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

 Slide the OFF/Low/High Volume Control Switch to turn the unit on. You will hear a sing-along song, fun phrase and a sound effect. The light will flash with the sounds.



 Press the LIGHT UP BUTTON to hear playful sing-along songs, fun phrases, sounds and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.



 Put an animal on the Magic ZoomiZone or pop the animal out of the Magic ZoomiZone to hear fun phrases, sounds and short tunes. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
