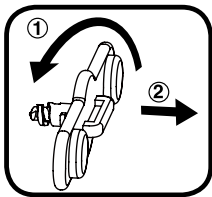

Unlock the Packaging Locks

- ① Turn the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise several times.
- ② Pull out and discard the packaging locks.



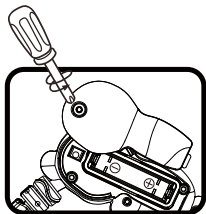
INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the electronic module inside the back of the **Shaking Sounds Bear Rattle**. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. Remove old battery by pulling up on one end of battery.



4. Install 1 new AAA battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries are recommended for maximum performance.)
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.

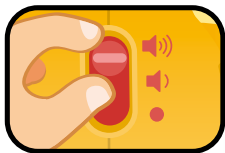

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Low/High Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Low/High Volume Switch** located on the back of the bear to the **Low Volume** (🔊) or **High Volume** (🔊🔊🔊) position. You will hear an opening tune, a playful phrase, and a song. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Low/High Volume Switch** to the **Off** (●) position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, **Shaking Sounds Bear Rattle** will automatically power down after approximately 25 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **Light up Leaf Button**, the **Flower Music Button** or by turning the **Spinning Flower**.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Leaf Button

Press the **Light Up Leaf Button** to be introduced to bear and his feelings, and to invite baby to shake the ring. The light will flash with the sounds.



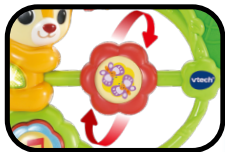
2. Flower Music Button

Press the **Flower Music Button** to hear fun melodies and songs. The light will flash with the sounds.



3. Spinning Flower

Turn the **Spinning Flower** to hear fun sounds. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the battery if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the battery.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the battery.
4. Turn the unit back **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a new battery.
