The buttons also play exciting music, catchy songs and fun phrases which support and encourage language development.

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit and use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
- If used or spent batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.



- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure the battery cover.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metal-hydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/ Volume Switch** to the **Low Volume**♣) or the **High Volume**♣) position.

You will hear a cute song and phrase. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to the **Off**position.



2. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Peek-a-Boo-Bear** will automatically shut off after approximately 50 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

NOTE: If the unit powers down during play, we suggest changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Number Button

When the bear is hiding in the pot, press the **Number Button** to pop up the bear, hear playful peek-aboo phrases and to learn numbers. If the bear is popped up, press the **Number Button** to hear a cute phrase about the bear. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. Music Button

Press the **Music Button** to hear one of three songs and a variety of melodies. If the bear is hiding in the pot, pressing the **Music Button** will pop up the bear. The light will flash with the sounds.



3. Hiding Bear

When the soft bear is popped up, press him down so he is hiding in the pot ready to play peek-a-boo. The bear will respond with fun phrases and a playful song. The light will flash with the sounds.



4. Bee Slider

Pull down on the **Bee Slider** to spin the spinner and hear phrases about the bees, playful sounds and music. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to excess moisture.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
