Unlock the Packaging Locks



 Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.

2 Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

GETTING STARTED

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AA batteries (AM-3/ LR6) following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new, alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

NOTE

This product is in try-me mode in the packaging. To activate normal play, turn the unit **Off**, then turn the unit back **On**. If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **On** O position. You will hear fun sounds, a short tune, phrases and songs in the selected modes. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** O position.



2. Mode Switch

Slide the **Mode Switch** to Music mode 2^{3} , Learn mode \mathbb{Q} or Play mode 2^{3} , you will hear an opening sequence of sounds, phrases and a song in each mode.



3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **DJ Jams Puppy** will automatically shut-off after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button, moving the joystick or turning the disc.

NOTE

If the unit shuts-off or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Instrument Buttons Press the Light Up Instrument Buttons to hear short instrument songs, tunes and melodies in Music mode, learn the names and sounds of instruments in Learn mode and hear how the melodies change sound with each instrument button in Play mode.The lights will flash with the sounds.



 Microphone Joystick
 Move the Microphone Joystick,
 up and down, or side to side to hear
 music with puppy sounds in Music
 mode, cute sing-along songs in Learn
 mode and melodies and phrases in
 Play mode. Moving the Joystick will
 make puppy swing and dance. The
 lights will flash with the sounds.



3. Turning Disc

Slide the **Turning Disc** to hear fun DJ scratch sounds, music and cute phrases depending on the selected mode.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
- 5. If the unit stops working or malfunctions, install a new set of batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
