



# **Unlock the Packaging Locks**



- ① Turn the packaging locks counterclockwise several times.
- 2 Pull out and discard the packaging locks.

# ACTIVATING NORMAL PLAY MODE

This product is in Try-Me mode in the packaging. Turn **On** the **Kidi Superstar Jr. DJ Mixer™**, turn the unit over and press the **Settings Button** on the back. You will hear 3 short beeps and the unit will restart. The **Kidi Superstar Jr. DJ Mixer™** is now ready for Normal Play! If the unit powers down during play, please install a new set of batteries.



# **GETTING STARTED**

# **Battery Removal and Installation**

- Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 3 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

# IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

### RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

# NOTE:

If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing or the light fades out, we suggest changing the batteries.

# PRODUCT FEATURES

# 1. OPPower Button

Press the **Power Button** to turn the unit **On**. Press the button again to turn the unit **Off**.



### 2. Mode Buttons

Press one of the four **Mode Buttons** to choose an activity.



### 3. Piano Keys

Press the **Piano Keys** to play notes in **Mix**, **Create** and **Trio Mode**.



### 4. Scratch Disc

Spin the **Scratch Disc** to add fun sound effects to your music. Lights will flash with the sounds.



### 5. Center Buttons

Press the **Center Buttons** to choose instrument and character sounds. The buttons will illuminate.



# 6. Music Style Buttons

Press a **Music Style Button** to choose Hip Hop, Chill, or Dance music. Press the button again to choose another track in the same style.



# 7. Stop Button

Press the **Stop Button** to stop the music or finish your recording in **Mix** or **Create Mode**.



# 8. Record Button

**Note:** When recording a new mix, your previous recording will be overwritten.



# 9. Play Button

After recording, press the **Play Button** to playback your mix.



# 10. Volume Buttons

Press the **Volume Controls +** | **-** to adjust the sound.



### 13. Settings Button

- Use the **Settings Button** to exit Try-me mode. *See page 2.*
- To adjust screen contrast, press the Settings Button to enter the menu. Spin the Scratch Disc ◎ to make a selection and press the Play Button ▶ to confirm.



### 14. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically turn **Off** after several minutes without input. The unit can be turned **On** again by pressing the **Power Button**. The unit will also automatically turn **Off** when battery power is low.

Note: If the Kidi Superstar Jr. DJ Mixer™ powers down repeatedly, please install a brand new set of batteries.

# **Modes**

# 1. Mix Mode



Create your own unique music combinations!

- Press the Center Buttons to mix up to four tracks and change them as you play.
- Press the Note Character to add or remove vocals.
- Press a Music Style Button to change tunes.
- Press the Mix Mode Button to add fun DJ phrases.
- Spin the Scratch Disc for fun scratching sound effects.
- Use the Piano Keys to add your own melodies.

# 2. Trio Mode



Form your own trio!

- Press the Center Buttons to add instruments and characters to your trio. Change them while you play.
- Press a Music Style Button to change tunes.
- Spin the Scratch Disc to jam in fun sound effects.
- Use the Piano Keys to add your own melodies.

# 3. Memory Mode



Follow the lights and sounds to match the pattern. Each game features a total of 6 rounds. Complete 6 rounds to win.

# 4. Create Mode



Create a melody using the instrument & character sounds in the **Center Buttons**.

- Press a Center Button to apply special character or instrument sounds to the Plano Keys & Scratch Disc.
- Use the Piano Keys to play the chosen sounds.
- Spin the Scratch Disc to hear your selected sound effects.
- Press a Music Style Button to change your backing track.
- Press the Create Mode Button again to jam in fun DJ phrases.

# **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On.** The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
