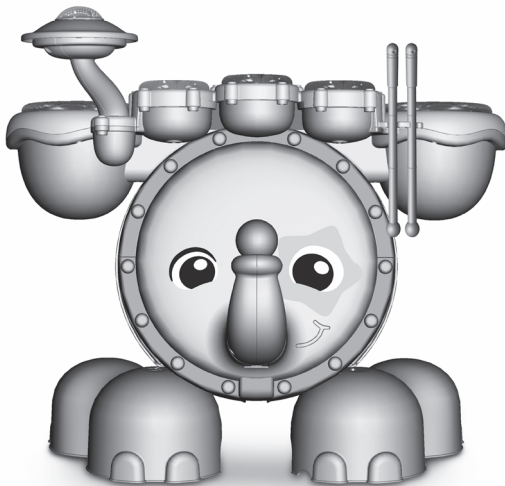

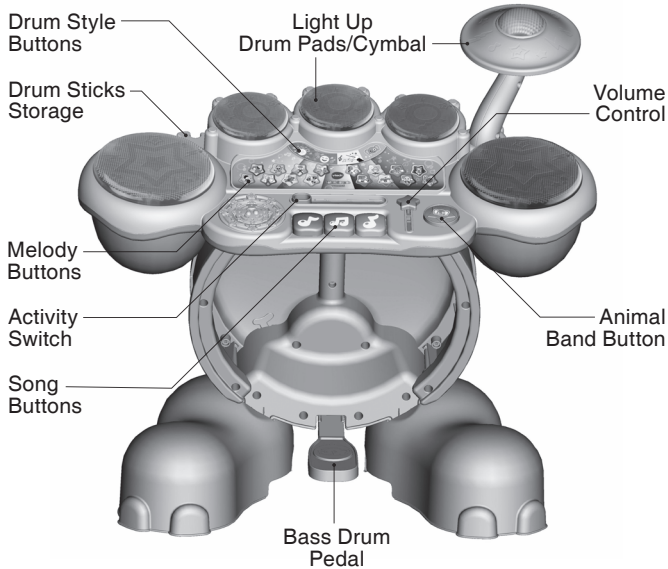

Tap and play the light up drum pads/cymbal and step on the bass drum pedal to hear drum sounds. Press the buttons on the panel to choose between different musical styles, including; rock music, orchestral, animal and silly sound effects. Play the drums as they light up, or compose your own creative masterpiece to develop cognitive, creative, musical and motor skills. Go wild, little drummer!

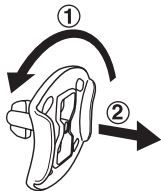

Unlock the packaging locks:



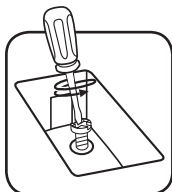
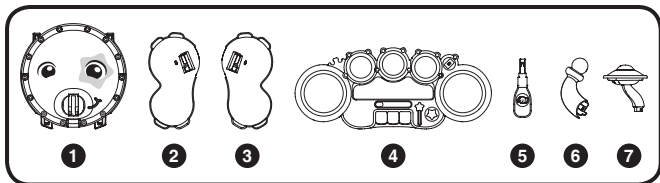
- ① Rotate the packaging lock anticlockwise for 90 degrees.

With the **VTech® Safari Sounds Drums**, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

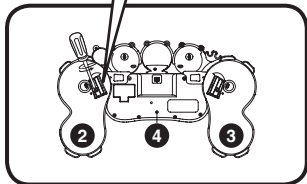
HOW TO ASSEMBLE THE DRUMS

NOTE: Connect all of the pieces until you hear a click.

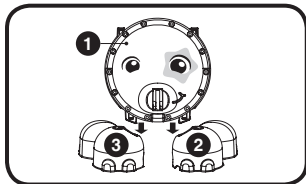

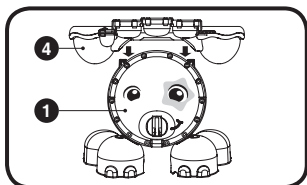
The screws are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.



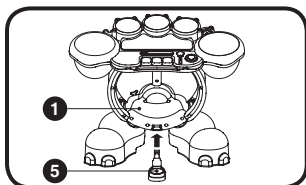
1. Use a screwdriver to separate the feet from the panel.



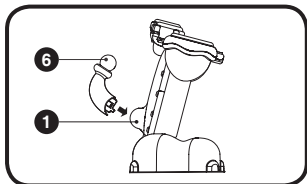
2. Connect the feet to the bass drum.



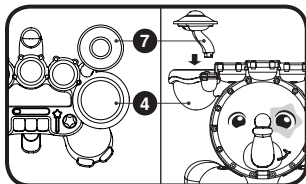
3. Connect the bass drum to the panel.



4. Connect the pedal to the bass drum.



5. Connect the trunk to the bass drum.

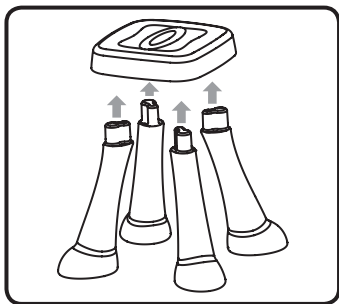


6. Connect the cymbal to the panel.

For your child's safety, please do not sit or lean on the unit or elephant trunk.

HOW TO ASSEMBLE THE STOOL

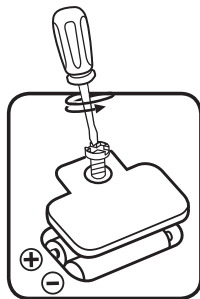
Fully insert the top end of the 4 legs into the slots on the bottom of the seat until they click into place.



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the panel.
3. Use a screwdriver to open the cover.
4. Install 2 new AA size (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new, alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



NOTE: If there is no response when the unit is switched on, please install brand new batteries and try switching the unit on again.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.



Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. Light Up Drum Pads/Cymbal

Tap the **Light Up Drum Pads/Cymbal** or step on the **Bass Drum Pedal** to play drum sounds. Press the **Drum Style Buttons** to choose between rock, orchestral, animal and silly drum sounds.



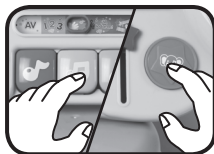
2. Melody Buttons

Press a **Melody Button** to hear a fun melody.



3. Song Buttons

Press the **Song Buttons** or **Animal Band Button** to play a sing-along song.



4. Activity Switch

Slide the **Activity Switch** to choose between **Counting**, **Catch the Lights**, **Follow the Leader** and **Freestyle Jam** activities.



5. Volume Control

Slide the **Volume Control** to adjust the volume.





ACTIVITIES

1. Counting



In this game mode you will be asked to count to a certain number. Tap the drums until you reach that number. The drums count aloud as you tap them. When you reach the correct number, you'll hear a new number to count to. Challenge yourself with three different levels of difficulty.

2. Catch the Lights



When a drum or cymbal lights up, tap it to catch the light. The light will move between the drum pads and cymbal. The more lights you catch, the faster the light will move. Catch as many lights as possible to move to the next level.

3. Follow the Leader



Watch the drum pads and cymbal light up in a pattern, then try to repeat that pattern by tapping the drum pads and cymbal in the order they just lit up. When you've correctly repeated the pattern, the next sequence will increase by one light. Repeat the sequences to advance to the next level.

4. Freestyle Jam



Tap the drum pads and cymbal, select melodies and choose sing-along songs to create your own composition.





CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
3. Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 
1. Please turn the unit **OFF**.
 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
 4. Turn the unit **ON**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
 5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
