



### INTRODUCTION

Baby Peek-a-Boo introduces numbers, counting, foods, feelings and more through over 60 cute phrases and realistic sounds effects.

#### WARNING:

All packing materials, such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks and tags are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE: Please keep instruction manual as it contains important information.

### **GETTING STARTED** BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- 2. Locate the battery cover in the back of the baby doll.
- 3. Install 2 new "AA" size (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

### How to install the battery box:

- 1. Remove the battery box and fabric pocket from the back of the doll.
- 2. After changing the batteries push the fabric pocket back inside the doll followed by the battery box.

### **BATTERY NOTICE**

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

#### Disposal of batteries and product

The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to

# **PRODUCT FEATURES**

### 1. OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

Locate the electronic box inside the back of your baby doll. To turn the unit **ON**, slide the **OFF/ VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH** to the low volume or high volume position. To turn the unit **OFF**, slide the **OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH** to the **OFF** position.



### 2. PEEK-A-BOO SENSOR

The **VTech® Baby Peek-a-Boo** is equipped with sensors around the eyes. Cover the eyes with one hand or both hands to activate these sensors.

### 3. VOLUME SWITCH 🗄

Slide the VOLUME SWITCH to select a high or low volume setting.

### 4. LIGHT-UP FLOWER

The **LIGHT-UP FLOWER** will flash with the sounds.

### 5. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the **VTech® Baby Peek-a-Boo** will automatically power-down after several minutes without input.The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

## ACTIVITIES

#### 1. Peek-a-Boo

To play peek-a-boo with baby cover the doll's eyes with both hands or one hand, then remove to play peek-a-boo and learn body parts and counting.

#### 2. Heart Button 🕔

Press the heart button to learn feelings, nursing phrases and hear fun phrases and sounds.

#### 3. Tummy Button 🐚

Press the Tummy Button to learn food, body parts and feelings, also sing-along with adorable songs.

### 4. Left Foot Button

Press the Left Foot Button to learn counting, daily life concepts and listen to fun melodies.

### 5. Right Foot Button




Press the Right Foot Button to learn body parts and enjoy up to 15 minutes of continuous soft lullables.

# **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and aways from any direct heat source or electromagnetic wave.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit back ON. The unit will now be ready to play again.
- If the product still does not work, replace with a new set of batteries.


