




- Rotate the packaging lock anticlockwise several times.

Buttons Description

Clock

Press this button to enter Clock mode or to go to sleep mode.

When the clock is not in use, sleep mode will activate to save power.

Games

Press this button to enter Games & Settings mode.

Choose a game, set the alarm or adjust system settings.

Caring Heart

Press this button to enter Caring Heart mode.

• Music

Press this button to enter Music mode.

Listen to the different types of built-in music. If an external music player (not included) is connected, you can listen to your own music.

FM Radio

Press this button to enter FM Radio mode.

• Light Button -

Press this button to adjust the light settings.

Volume Button ())

Press this button to adjust the volume.

Direction Buttons ◀••

Press these buttons to make a selection.

OK Button OK

Press this button to confirm your selection.

If in Clock mode, pressing this button tells the current time.

Audio-in Jack

Plug in an external music player (not included) using the supplied audio cable to listen to music.

USB Type-C[®] Port

Plug in a 5V 1.5A USB adaptor (not included) here.

· Magic Sensor

Works only when the magic sensor icon \mathfrak{F} is shown on the screen. Wave your palm above the magic sensor to see magic effects.

WARNING

- Please keep your KidiMagic® Galaxy Light away from strong light or direct sunlight, as it will interfere with the magic sensor.
- To avoid poor operation, please ensure there are no obstacles, such as a shelf, close to the top of the device.
- If the sensor detects an obstacle that impedes the performance of the device, you will see a warning icon on the screen.




Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery. (We suggest removing the battery in the first or third position, and then taking out the others from the battery box).
- Install 4 new AA (AM-3/LR6)
 batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.





IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.

- · Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

TO BEGIN USING KIDIMAGIC® GALAXY LIGHT

HOW TO EXIT TRY ME MODE

If you've just taken the **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** out of the packaging for the first time, you need to disable Try Me Mode before playing.

To disable Try Me Mode, press the OK Button to turn on the unit and then plug in the included audio cable to the audio-in jack.

Note: The included batteries are for demo use only. We recommend to use an adaptor or replace the included batteries with new batteries before using **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light**.

INITIAL SETUP

Press any button to turn the unit on. When the unit is first turned on, you will be asked to set the time and date.

TIME SETUP

The default time is 8:00 in 12 hour mode.

- Press the OK Button to highlight the next item:
 Time Format, Time Input and Confirmation icon.
- Press the •/• buttons to adjust the value of the highlighted item.



To save the current settings, press the OK Button while highlighting
the tick icon ✓ . Otherwise, press the ◀•/•▶ buttons to choose
this icon ⑤ to set the time again.

DATE SETUP

The default date format is DD/MM/YY.

- Press the OK Button to highlight the next item:
 Date Format, Date Input and Confirmation icon.
- Press the •/• buttons to adjust the value of the highlighted item.
- To save the current settings, press the OK Button while highlighting
 the tick icon ✓ . Otherwise, press the ◀•/•▶ buttons to choose
 this icon ⑤ to set the date again.



Note: The Time and Date setup can be found in the Settings menu after pressing the Games Button.

POWER SAVING AND STANDBY MODE

To preserve battery life, **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** will automatically enter standby mode if there is no operation for a period of time. You can also press the Clock Button to go to standby mode if you are already in clock mode. The current time will be displayed, even in standby mode. Press any button to wake up the unit.

MAGIC SENSOR CONTROL

The magic sensor detects palm movement above it. Wave your palm left or right to activate the sensor. You will be able to select different light effects and play games using it.

The magic sensor is available only if the magic sensor icon $\hat{\boldsymbol{\Phi}}$ is shown at the top of the screen.

Note: Keep the **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** away from anything above the sensor that could block it (e.g. wall, ceiling, shelf, cabinet, etc.) as this will reduce the sensor's performance.



LIGHT CONTROL

Press the Light Button for the below light settings, use the •• •• buttons to choose between Light Mode, Brightness, Flower Light and Projection.



Press the ••••• buttons to switch between flower light, screen display light and projection on or off status, as well as the motion speed of the projection light if the projection is set to on.

Brightness

Press the **1** / **1** buttons to control the brightness.

Flower Light

Press the . / . buttons to change the flower light effect.

Projection

Press the **●•/•** buttons to change the projection light effect.

VOLUME CONTROL

Press the Volume Button to adjust the volume. Use the . / . buttons to decrease or increase the volume



LONG-TIME LIGHT ON FEATURE (When using a power supply)

There is a long-time light on feature for KidiMagic® Galaxy Light. You can set the light to stay on for a long time in some modes when an adaptor is being used. We recommend the use of an adaptor whenever possible. If you are using batteries, the long-time light on feature will not be available

ACTIVITIES

1.Clock and Tell Time



Press the Clock Button to go to the clock mode, the current time will be displayed on screen. The light will turn on for a short time with it.



- Wave your palm to the left or right above KidiMagic® Galaxy Light to change the flower light effect.
- Press the d / buttons to change the style for the time display.
- Press the OK Button to listen to the time spoken aloud.

2. Games and Settings (TA)

Bumblebee Adventure

Bumblebee is going on an adventure to get honey from the flowers; it will constantly drift toward the bottom of the screen. Press the OK Button to control the bee to fly up slightly press-by-press. Help bumblebee avoid obstacles and fly to as many flowers as possible.



Hide and Seek

The butterfly likes playing hide and seek, it will hide behind a flower. Then the flowerpots will keep swapping positions a few times and stop. After the flowerpots stop, can you find which flower the butterfly is hidden behind?



Press the $\P \cdot / \bullet \mathbb{D}$ buttons or wave your palm to choose a different flowerpot, and press the OK Button to confirm your selection.

Mushroom Bunny

Bunny is picking mushrooms in the forest, but the forest is full of obstacles, can you help bunny to avoid obstacles and pick more mushrooms?

Press the •/• buttons or wave your palm to move the bunny to the left or right.



Magic Garden

Let's plant and grow the best flowers in the magic garden. Collect different ingredients to create a magic seed. Plant them to discover different magic flowers.



Press the OK Button or wave your palm to collect the target ingredients.

Settings

A total of four settings can be found in this mode. Press the ◀•/•▶ buttons to choose between Alarm, Auto off Timer, Time Setting and Date Setting.



Alarm

There are 2 alarms that can be set.

To set the alarm

Choose the desired alarm by pressing the
 | • | • | • | buttons and then the OK Button.



- When in the alarm time setting screen, press the ◀•/•buttons to change the value and to set the alarm on/off.
- Press the OK Button to go to the next item: Alarm Time, Alarm Once Tme / Alarm On Everyday / Alarm Off, Ring Tone, Confirmation icon.
- Once you have selected an alarm tone, press the OK Button to pop out the ring tone setting menu. You can choose a different alarm tone and adjust the alarm volume by pressing the
 ● buttons.



 To save the current settings, press the OK Button while highlighting the tick icon ✓. Or you can press the ◀•/•► buttons to choose this icon ⑤ to set the alarm again.

Stop the Alarm Ringing

a maximum of 3 times.

- When the alarm is ringing, to turn the alarm off, choose the icon and press the OK Button.

 When the alarm is ringing, press any activity button or wave your palm above the device to enter snooze mode. The alarm will ring again after 5 minutes for

Auto-off Timer

You can set the amount of time the light is on in clock mode, and the auto-off timer for Projection, FM Radio and External Music Connection.



Clock Light

Press the •• • buttons to select the desired length of time: 1 minute, 30 minutes, 60 minutes or disable auto off. The disable auto-off option is only available when an adaptor is in use.

Projection

 Press the ◀•/•▶ buttons to select the desired length of time: 15 minutes, 30 minutes, 60 minutes or disable auto off. The disable auto-off option is only available when an adaptor is in use.

FM Radio

 Press the ◀•/•▶ buttons to select the desired length of time: 60 minutes, 120 minutes, 240 minutes or disable auto off. The disable auto-off option is only available when an adaptor is in use.

External Music Connection

 Press the ◀•/• buttons to select the desired length of time: 30 minutes, 60 minutes, 120 minutes or disable auto off. The disable auto-off option is only available when an adaptor is in use.

Time Set-up

The default time is 8:00 in 12 hour mode.

 Press the OK Button to highlight the next item: Time Format, Time Input and Confirmation icon.



- Press the · · buttons to adjust the value of the highlighted item.
- To save the current settings, press the OK Button while highlighting the tick icon ✓.
 Otherwise, press the ◆ / buttons to choose this icon ★ to set the time again.

Date Set-up

The default date format is DD/MM/YY.

 Press the OK Button to highlight the next item: Date Format, Date Input and Confirmation icon.



- Press the · · buttons to adjust the value of the highlighted item.
- To save the current settings, press the OK Button while highlighting the tick icon ✓. Otherwise, press the ◀•/•b buttons to choose this icon ★ to set the date again.

Note: The time and date will be reset if there is no power supplied to the unit. The time and date will also reset after installing new batteries or when powering on with an adaptor.

3. Caring Heart 🐬

Fortune Teller

Let **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** tell your fortune by asking it a yes or no question.

Place your palm above **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** or hold the OK Button to ask a yes or no question. Your question will be answered when you move your palm away or release the OK Button.



Note: This activity is just for fun only.

Mystical Mind Reading

There are 9 cards with different symbols. Choose a symbol from one of the 9 cards. Remember the card and its position, and then press the OK Button to start playing. Make selections by following the instructions. Then you will be asked to pick up a card from 9 cards, and see if your memorised card is shown at the end!



Magic Scanner

Let KidiMagic® Galaxy Light reveal which magical elf you are! Place your palm above KidiMagic® Galaxy Light to scan it and have your magic elf revealed!



My Feelings

How do you feel today? Share your feelings with **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light**, and store your happiness into your emotion bank.

If you are happy, you can get a happy token stored in the emotion bank.



If you are not happy, **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** will try and help you, press the **4**•/•**b** buttons to choose a way to help comfort yourself.

Clean Heart

To help drive away negative feelings, this activity is here to help clean your heart! Wave your palm above **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** to clean your heart shown on screen, scrubbing it clean to reveal a bright shining heart.



Calm Breathing

Having a slow and calm breathing exercise helps us relax and care for our mental wellbeing. Enter this activity and follow the instructions to soothe and relax.



4.Music 🦙

In this mode, you can listen to different styles of music, even your own music via plugging in an external music player (not included) to **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light**.

· Built-in Music

There are different styles of built-in melodies with mood lighting for you to enjoy!





- Wave your palm left and right above KidiMagic® Galaxy Light to change the flower light effect.
- In Relaxing Music, there are additional soothing sounds you can turn on or off. When listening to the Relaxing Music, press the OK Button to pop out the selection menu.

External Music Connection

Plug in an external music player (not included) to KidiMagic® Galaxy Light and listen to your own music!

Note: Please disconnect your external music player (not included) and the audio cable from KidiMagic® Galaxy Light if you do not want to listen to music.



Note:

The Volume Controls on the **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** cannot control the volume of an external music player (not included).

The Auto-off timer that can be adjusted in Settings under Games mode only works to bring the **KidiMagic® Galaxy Light** into standby mode and does not control or turn off any external devices.

5.FM Radio

Let's listen to your favourite FM Radio stations. The frequency range is 87.5 - 108 MHz.

- Press the ◀•/•▶ buttons to search through the frequency range manually.
- Hold the •/• buttons to auto-search a channel.
- Press the OK Button to select different radio stations.

Note:

- To get good radio reception, adjust the position of the antenna. The antenna is situated on the left side of the unit.
- In FM Radio mode, all lights will be turned off except for the screen light. The screen light will dim after a short time to save the power consumption. To make it brighter, press any button.
- The light effect cannot be changed in FM Radio mode to help increase the reception.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Handle the device carefully.
- 2. Keep the device out of dusty or dirty areas.
- 3. Keep the device out of moisture or extreme temperature.
- Do not disassemble the device. If a problem occurs, remove and replace the batteries to reset the device, or try new batteries.
- Do not drop the device on a hard surface and do not expose it to or immerse it in water.
