This product is in Try-Me mode in the packaging. After opening the package, please turn **Hoppin' Boppin' Froggy** off and on again to proceed with normal play.

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Locate the battery cover located on the bottom of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- Remove used batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 4 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

On/Off/Mode Switch

To turn the unit On, slide the On/
Off/Mode Switch to the Bounce
Mode (♣) or the Learning Mode
(♠) position. You will hear a song,
phrases and sounds. To turn the unit
Off, slide the On/Off/Mode Switch
to the Off (♠) position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Hoppin' Boppin' Froggy** will automatically power down after approximately 35 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **Light Up Button** or by sliding the **On/Off/Mode Switch** to the **Bounce Mode** or the **Learning Mode** position.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a brand new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Button

Press the **Light Up Button** to hear songs, phrases, melodies and sound effects! In **Bounce Mode**, Froggy will invite your child to play the Bounce and Freeze game! In **Learning Mode**, Froggy introduces animals! The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
