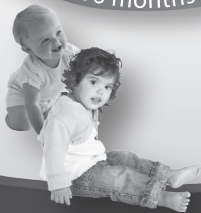

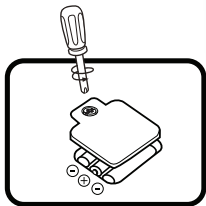
INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned off.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery
4. Install 3 new 1.5V AA (LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box (for best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheeled bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the **Big Business Baby Desk** safety comes first. Adult assembly is required. For your child's safety, do not let them play with this toy until it is fully assembled.

1. Insert each table leg into the sockets on the bottom of the desk. Press firmly until each leg is secure. Check that all legs are stable before use.



2. To use the desk as a tabletop, gently pull the legs away from the desk. It can then be placed on any flat surface for the child to use.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. Off/Low/High Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **Off/Low/High Volume Switch** to the **Low Volume**  or **High Volume**  position. You will hear fun sounds, a song and a phrase. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **Off/Low/High Volume Switch** to the **Off**  position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Big Business Baby Desk** will automatically power down after approximately 16 seconds of inactivity. To turn the unit back on, press any button on the keyboard, the star button on the book, or the telephone base.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Call Button

Press the **Call Button** on the keyboard to introduce phone and video calls. Fun sounds and songs will play to encourage the child to pretend to call. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. Number Button

Press the **Number Button** on the keyboard to introduce numbers. Fun sounds and songs will play to encourage the child to count. The light will flash with the sounds.



3. Alphabet Button

Press the **Alphabet Button** on the keyboard to introduce letters. Fun sounds and songs will play to encourage the child to learn and play. The light will flash with the sounds.



4. Magnifying Glass Button

Press the **Magnifying Glass Button** on the keyboard to play fun sounds and songs and to encourage the child to explore the desk. The light will flash with the sounds.



5. Star Button

Press the **Star Button** to hear fun sounds and songs. The light will flash with the sounds.



6. Mode Switch

Slide the **Mode Switch** to choose between **Music Mode**, **Learn Mode** or **Explore Mode**. The light will flash with the sounds.



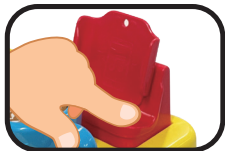
7. Mouse

Slide the **Mouse** to hear fun sounds and a phrase. The light will flash with the sounds.



8. Telephone Base

Press the **Telephone Base** to hear fun sounds and songs. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit back **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
