

Thank you for purchasing the **VTech® Pop-a-Ball® Pop-a-Ball Pit.** Your little one will love playing in the ball pit, throwing the balls in the hoop and counting to ten with fun sounds. Press the orange button to hear more fun sounds and responses as the balls pop!



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** is turned **OFF.**
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the **Pop-a-Ball Pit**. Use a coin or a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
- Install 3 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).



4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- · Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- · Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- · Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- · Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- · Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the **Pop-a-Ball Pit**, safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

WARNING! This product contains small screws. For your child's safety, do not let your child play with the toy until it is fully assembled. Adult supervision is recommended.

- Insert the Electronic Activity Panel into the Activity Panel Base. Using a screwdriver, insert then tighten the two small screws into the screw holes located on the back of the Activity Panel Base.
- Place the Activity Panel Base into the ball pit. Then, insert the two blue attachment straps on the back of the ball pit to the slots on the rear of the Activity Panel Base. You should then pull on the straps until the loops pull through the slots. Next, hook the two blue side straps to both sides of the Activity Panel Base.
- 3. Slide the Activity Panel against the fabric wall. Locate the two slots on the back of the panel, then secure it to the fabric wall using the Attachment Clip. You will hear the Attachment Clip snap into place when inserted correctly.







PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Mode Switch

To turn the **Pop-a-Ball Pit ON**, slide the **On/Off/Mode Switch** to the **Counting Mode (123)** or **Animal Mode (**²/₂³) position. You will hear a song and a welcoming phrase. To turn the **Pop-a-Ball Pit OFF**, slide the **On/Off/Mode Switch** to the **OFF** (●) position.



Volume Control Switch Slide the Volume Control Switch to the High Volume (◄))) or Low Volume (◄))) position to adjust the volume.



3. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** will automatically shut off after approximately 50 seconds without input. The **Pop-a-Ball Pit** can be turned on again by pressing any button.

NOTE: If the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** repeatedly shuts off while playing, we suggest changing the batteries.

The infrared light sensors in the hoop are sensitive to sunlight. The sensors may not perform properly in brightly lit, sunny rooms or under direct sunlight.

4. Ball Pit Storage

To fold up the collapsible ball pit for storage, remove the **Activity Panel Base** and put the multicoloured balls into the middle of the ball pit. Fold the panel opposite the tallest panel over the multicoloured balls, then fold in the two sides. Tie the two ties together.



ACTIVITIES

1. Hoop

Throw the multicoloured balls into the **Hoop** to hear them be counted in **Counting Mode** or to hear fun sounds in **Animal Mode**. The lights will flash with the sounds.

2. Purple Button

Press the **Purple Button** to move the hippo up and down. You will hear fun sounds in **Counting Mode**. In **Animal Mode** you will be introduced to the hippo through fun phrases and a song. The lights will flash with the sounds.

3. Orange Button


Press the **Orange Button** to pop the balls out of the bowl. You will hear a song, short tunes and fun sounds in **Counting Mode**. In **Animal Mode** you will hear playful phrases and fun sounds. The lights will flash with the sounds.

4. Yellow Button

Press the **Yellow Button** to move the elephant up and down. You will hear fun sounds in **Counting Mode**. In **Animal Mode** you will be introduced to the elephant through fun phrases and a song. The lights will flash with the sounds.

5. Bird

Twist the **Bird** to hear fun questions in **Counting Mode**. In **Animal Mode** you will hear fun phrases about the bird, bird sounds, a song and melodies. The lights will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** on hard surfaces and do not expose the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the **Pop-a-Ball Pit OFF**.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the **Pop-a-Ball Pit** ON. It should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
