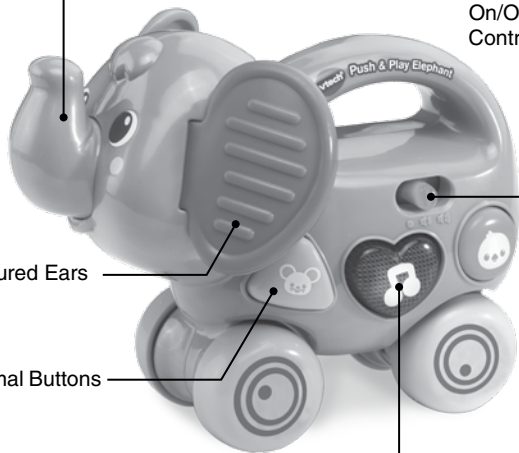

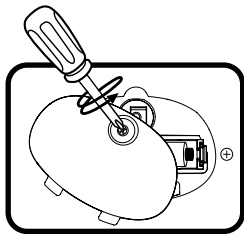

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw.
3. Install 1 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of a new alkaline battery is recommended for maximum performance).
4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metal-hydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.

- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

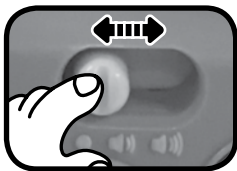

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Control Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Control Switch** to the **Low Volume** (🔊) or **High Volume** (🔊🔊) position. You will hear a song, a phrase and a short tune. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Control Switch** to the **Off** (●) position.



2. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Push & Play Elephant** will automatically power down after approximately 45 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing one of the buttons.

NOTE: If the unit repeatedly powers down when playing, we recommend changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Button

Press the **Light Up Button** to learn about numbers and to hear fun phrases, playful sounds and melodies.



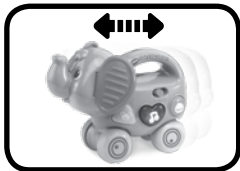
2. Animal Buttons

Press the **Animal Buttons** to learn about animals, shapes and to hear songs, playful sounds and melodies.



3. Motion Sensor

Push the elephant to activate the **Motion Sensor** and hear a variety of playful sounds and short phrases. If a melody is playing, activate the **Motion Sensor** to hear fun sounds play over the melody.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

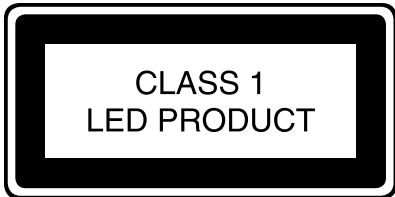
1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to excess moisture.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **OFF**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit back **ON**. The unit will now be ready to play again.
5. If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
