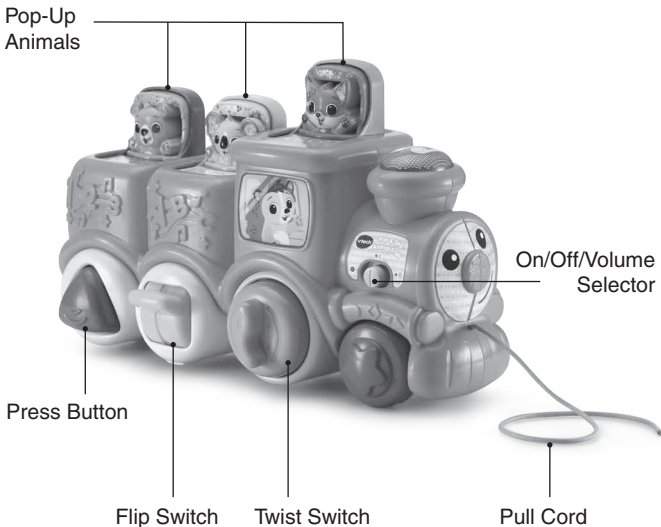

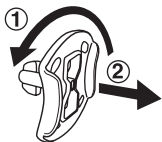
WARNING

Unlock the Packaging Locks

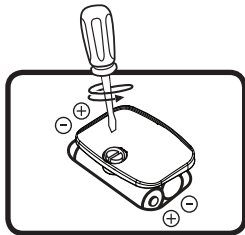


- ① Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- ② Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AAA batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Selector

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Selector** to the Low Volume (🔊) or the High Volume (🔊🔊) position. You will hear sounds, phrases and a song. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Selector** to the **Off** ● position.



2. Pull Cord

To convert the unit from a push toy to a pull toy, remove the pull cord from the storage compartment on the bottom of the train. For your child's safety, we suggest you store the pull cord in the compartment until your child is walking.



3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Pop & Sing Animal Train** will automatically shut off after approximately 75 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Press Button

Press the **Button** to pop up the bear. You will hear the animal name and a playful phrase as well as a fun song, sounds and tunes. Press the **Button** after the animal is already popped up to hear a cute phrase or a tune. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. Flip Switch

Flip the **Switch** to pop up the koala. You will hear the animal name and a playful phrase as well as a fun song, sounds and tunes. Flip the **Switch** after the animal is already popped up to hear a cute phrase or a tune. The light will flash with the sounds.



3. Twist Switch

Turn the **Switch** to pop up the fox. You will hear the animal name and a playful phrase as well as a fun song, sounds and tunes. Turn the **Switch** after the animal is already popped up to hear a cute phrase or a tune. The light will flash with the sounds.



4. **Pop-Up Animals**

Press the **Pop-Up Animals** back into the train to hear a playful phrase, a tune and fun sounds. The light will flash with the sounds.



5. **Motion Sensor**

Pull or push the train to hear fun train sounds and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to excess moisture.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Please turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
