INSTRUCTIONS

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw. Then remove the cover.
3. If used battery is present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 1 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.
Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.

Please dispose of your product and batteries responsibly.

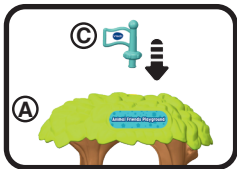
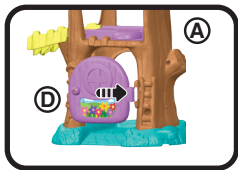
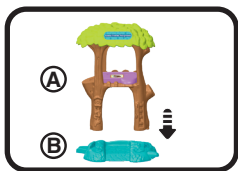


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

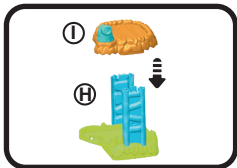
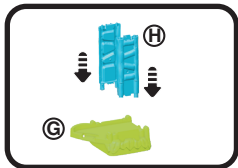
With the **Animal Friends Playground** safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required.

SMALL COMPONENT ASSEMBLY

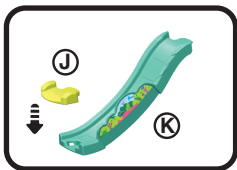
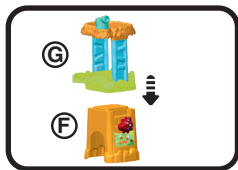
1. First, Insert **(A)** into **(B)**, then insert **(E) (D) (C)** into **(A)** as shown. You will hear a click sound to indicate the pieces are secure.



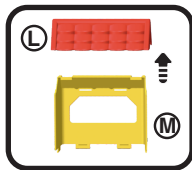
2. Insert **(H)** into **(G)**, then insert **(I)** into **(H)**. You will hear a click sound to indicate the pieces are secure. Please note that they cannot be detached once connected.



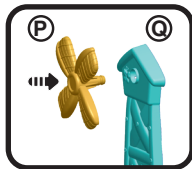
Then, insert ⑥ into ⑤, join ⑩ into ⑪ as shown. You will hear a click sound to indicate the pieces are secure. Please note that they cannot be detached once connected.



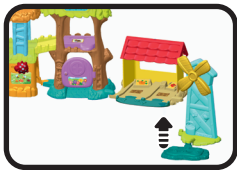
3. Insert ⑭ into ⑬. Second, insert ⑭ into ⑮ as shown. Then, insert ⑯ into ⑮. You will hear a click sound to indicate the pieces are secure.



4. Insert ⑰ into ⑱, then insert into ⑲. You will hear a click sound to indicate the pieces are secure. Please note they cannot be detached once connected. Lastly, join ⑲ to ⑳ as shown.



5. Join the five assembled parts together as shown. Once you've completed the above steps, you are ready to play! Refer to the product image on the cover page of the manual for one way to set up the **Animal Friends Playground**.



PRODUCT FEATURES

1. Heart Button

Press the Heart Button to turn on or wake the unit up.



2. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the unit will automatically power-down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can only be turned on again by pressing the **Light Up Heart Button**

NOTE

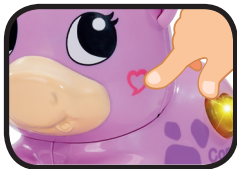
If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES - CONNIE COW

1. Press the **Light Up Heart Button** to turn the unit **ON**. You will hear a song, a phrase and fun sounds.



2. Touch the **Heart Shaped Touch Point** on Connie's cheek to hear a kiss sound and animal noises.



3. Pushing the animal along will trigger a song, phrase and melody.



PRODUCT FEATURES – PLAYGROUND

Play with Connie Cow or other Animal Friends characters (each sold separately) on the Playground. Simply place Connie on a location to play.

ACTIVITIES

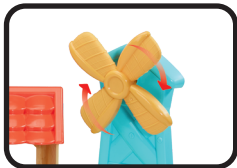
1. Sliding Ladybird

Move the **Ladybird** back and forth for added pretend play.



2. Spinning Windmill

Turn the **Windmill** for mechanical play.



3. Swinging Gate

Open and close the **Door** to let Connie in and out of the house.



4. Turning Flag & Telescope

Place the Connie on the **Telescope** platform and twist the **Telescope** or **Flag** for mechanical play.



CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit sit for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
5. If the unit is not working properly, install a brand new set of batteries.
