







GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the elephant. Use a coin or a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open up the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 3 new AA batteries following the diagram inside the battery box.
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.





BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

MISE EN GARDE

Les piles fournies avec le produit permettent de tester le jouet en magasin mais ne sont pas des piles longue durée.

- Seules des piles du type recommandé doivent être utilisées.
- Ne pas utiliser des piles ou des accumulateurs endommagés.
- Mettre en place les piles ou les accumulateurs en respectant les polarités + et -.
- Ne pas mettre les bornes d'une pile ou d'un accumulateur en courtcircuit (en reliant directement le + et le -).
- Enlever les piles ou les accumulateurs usagés du jouet.
- Retirer les piles ou les accumulateurs en cas de non-utilisation prolongée.
- Ne les jeter ni au feu ni dans la nature.
- Ne pas tenter de recharger des piles non rechargeables.
- Enlever, lorsque c'est possible, les accumulateurs du jouet pour les recharger.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required. Adult supervison recommended.

 Lay the storage compartment on the back of the elephant. Snap the lower part of the compartment onto the elephant, then insert the two screws at the top of the compartment to secure the storage compartment.



Insert the handle into the slot on the back of the walker legs.



Insert the back legs into the slot on the back of the walker.



Insert the three screws into the holes on the back of the handle to secure it to the main body of the walker.



PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Selector

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Selector** to the Low volume **■**()) or the High volume **■**()) position. You will hear a song, sound and a phrase. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Selector** to the **Off ●** position.



2. Speed Control Switch

The Toddle & Stroll Musical Elephant Walker™ is equipped with a speed control switch on the two back wheels of the walker. Position one is for babies who are just learning to take their first steps. This position prevents the walker from moving too quickly. Position two is intended for the more skillful toddler and will allow the walker to move more freely. When adjusting the speed control switch, please make sure both wheels are set to the same position.



3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Toddle & Stroll Musical Elephant Walker™** will automatically shut off after approximately 80 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button. Pushing the walker will not turn the unit back on.

NOTE: If the unit powers down while playing, we suggest changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Color Buttons

Press the **Color Buttons** to learn about colors, shapes and numbers. Press the buttons three times to hear a playful song. The drum will flash with the sound.



2. Drum Button

Press the **Drum Button** to hear drum sounds, short tunes and songs. The light will flash with the sound.



3. Hands-On Play

Little ones can practice motor skills by exploring the Turning Trunk, Spinning Ball, Sliding Saxophone and Turning Gear. Play peek-a-boo in the mirror!



4. Wheel Sensor

Push the **Elephant Walker** to hear melodies and the Alphabet Song. When the Alphabet Song is playing, stop pushing the walker to hear the song stop, then push the walker to continue the song. The drum will flash with the sound.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
