



Unlock the packaging locks:




- Rotate the packaging lock 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- 2 Pull out the packaging lock and discard.

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Locate the battery cover and use a screwdriver to loosen the screws and open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one side of each battery.



- Install 3 new LR44 batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screws to secure.

▲ WARNING:

This product contains a button or coin cell battery. A swallowed button or coin cell battery can cause internal chemical burns in as little as two hours and lead to death. Dispose of used batteries immediately. Keep new and used batteries away from children. If you think batteries might have been swallowed or placed inside any part of the body, seek immediate medical attention.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use three LR44 alkaline button cell batteries only for this toy.
- The button cell batteries used with this product should be kept away from small children who might still put things in their mouths. If the button cell batteries are swallowed, consult a doctor immediately.

- Insert the button cell batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not use damaged button cell batteries.
- Do not short-circuit the button cell battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted button cell batteries from the product.
- Remove button cell batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of button cell batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable button cell batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **On** O position. You will hear a playful caterpillar song, a phrase and sounds. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off Switch** to the **Off** \blacklozenge position.



2. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Shake & Sounds Caterpillar** will automatically power down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **Light Up Heart Button**. The **Motion Sensor** will not turn the unit back on.

Note:

If the unit repeatedly powers down while playing, or the light up heart button fades out, we suggest changing the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Heart Button

Press the **Light Up Heart Button** to hear songs, phrases, sounds and melodies. The light will flash with the sounds.




2. Motion Sensor

Shake the caterpillar rattle to trigger the **Motion Sensor**. You will hear sounds & phrases and see the light flash with the sounds.



3. Tactile Stimulation

Encourage your baby's sense of touch with the **Textured Handle** and **Ribbon Legs**.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
