Unlock the Packaging Locks




- Rotate the packaging lock 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove the old batteries by pulling up on one end of the batteries.



5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.



RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Control Switch To turn the unit On, slide the On/Off/Volume Control Switch to the Low volume () or High volume ()) position. You will hear a fun sound, phrases and a song. To turn the unit Off. slide the

2. Pull Cord Storage

the **Off** oposition.

To change kitty from a pull toy to a push toy, store the pull cord by opening the battery compartment and tucking the cord inside. To use as a pull toy again, open the battery compartment and extend the cord. Lay the cord in the notch and close



the battery compartment. For your child's safety, we suggest you store the pull cord in the compartment until your child is walking and to supervise your child when playing with the pull cord.

3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the unit will power down after approximately 35 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES


1. Light Up Music Button

Press the Music Button to hear different familiar melodies. The lights will flash with the sounds.



2. Number Button

Press the Number Button to learn number counting. The lights will flash with the sounds.



3. Body Parts Button

Press the Body Parts Button to hear facts about the kitty.



4. Swinging Tail and Motion Sensor

Pull and push the kitty to swing the tail and hear fun sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
