

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the VTech® Pop-a-Ball® Rock & Pop Turtle. Dropping the five included multicoloured balls into the turtle's tummy makes the turtle spin around on the floor, popping out the balls at random. By pressing the two buttons on the turtle's shell, your child will learn about numbers, turtle facts and much more through fun and encouraging phrases and sounds.



INCLUDED IN THIS PACKAGE

- One VTech® Pop-a-Ball® Rock & Pop Turtle
- Five multicoloured balls

All packing materials, such as tape, plastic WARNING.

sheets, packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties and packaging screws are not part of this toy. and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE: Please keep this parent's guide as it contains

important information.

The legs of the turtle can pop up things in light weight. For safety, do not put other things into the tummy and legs of the the turtle except the balls provided.

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- Make sure the unit is turned **OFF**. 1
- Locate the battery cover on the back of the turtle. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw
- 3. Install 4 new AA (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new batteries is recommended for maximum performance).
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries or fully charged NI-MH (Nickel Metalhydride) rechargeable batteries for best performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Control Switch

To turn the unit ON, slide the On/Off/Volume Control Switch to the Low Volume ((a))) or High Volume ((a)))) position. You will hear a song and a welcoming phrase. To turn the unit OFF, slide the On/Off/Volume Control Switch to the OFF ((a)) position.



2. Mode Switch

Slide the **Mode Switch** located on the bottom of the turtle to select the Drop & Pop Mode (**) or Spin & Sing Mode (**).



3. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Rock & Pop Turtle** will automatically shut off after approximately two minutes without input. The **Rock & Pop Turtle** can be turned on again by pressing the buttons or by switching modes.

NOTE: If the **Rock & Pop Turtle** repeatedly shuts off, we suggest changing the batteries.

The infrared light sensors in the turtle's tummy are sensitive to sunlight. The sensors may not perform properly in brightly lit, sunny rooms or under direct sunlight.

The motor does not work well under pressure. For optimal performance, do not press or hold the turtle down while the motor is running.

This product is in "try me" mode in the packaging. After opening the package, remove the "try me" tag from the back of the turtle, then turn it off and on to proceed with normal play.

ACTIVITIES

1. Music Button

Press the **Music Button** to hear playful melodies in **Drop & Pop Mode**, or playful songs in **Spin & Sing Mode**. When a melody or a song is playing, drop a ball into the turtle's tummy to hear fun sounds play over the music. The light will flash with the sounds.



2. Learning Button

Press the **Learning Button** to hear fun sounds, learn about parts of the turtle's body and colours in **Drop & Pop Mode**, or hear playful phrases and music in **Spin & Sing Mode**. When music is playing, drop a ball into the turtle's tummy to hear fun sounds play over the music. The light will flash with the sounds



3. Two Play Modes

Drop a ball into the **Turtle's Tummy** to learn about numbers, hear playful phrases and music in **Drop & Pop Mode**, or to hear fun phrases and melodies in **Spin & Sing Mode**. When music is playing, drop a ball into the turtle's tummy to hear fun sounds play over the music. The light will flash with the sounds.



4. Popping Play

In Drop & Pop Mode, drop the multicoloured balls into the turtle's tummy to watch the balls pop out from the turtle's legs, into their tummy and onto the floor. In Spin & Sing Mode, drop the multicoloured balls into the turtle's tummy to watch them pop out onto the floor.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- Remove the batteries when the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
