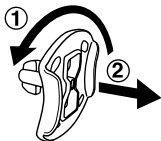

Unlock the Packaging Locks:

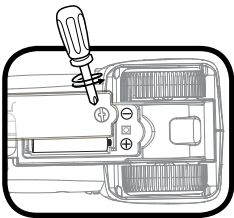


- ① Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.
- ② Pull out and discard the packaging locks.

GETTING STARTED

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Find the battery cover on the bottom of the scooter, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box (for best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation.

Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product




The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

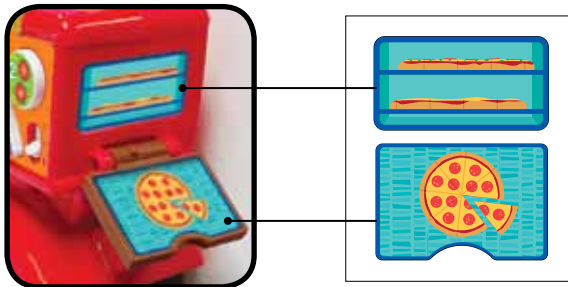

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to the **Low Volume** () or **High Volume** ()) position. You will hear sounds, phrases and a song. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Switch** to the **Off** (●) position.



2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Dash 'n' Deliver Scooter** will automatically power down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned back on by pressing any button.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

For your child's safety, only use the scooter on the floor. Do not press and release the vehicle on hair, skin or clothing. Loose items may get caught in the wheels during motion. Do not block the scooter's path with hands, feet or other body parts when it's moving forward. If something gets caught in the wheels, lift the scooter away from your child to stop its movement. Adult supervision required.



ACTIVITIES

1. Kitty Button

Press the **Kitty Button** to hear playful sounds and phrases. The scooter will roll forward, the puppy will turn its head, and the light will flash along with the sound.



2. Shape Buttons

Press the **Shape Buttons** to discover numbers, shapes, and colours. Your child will enjoy playful songs, phrases, and melodies. Pressing Kitty during a melody adds fun sounds on top, while the light flashes along with the sound.



3. Back Door

Pull open the **Back Door** to reveal delicious pizzas ready for delivery.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

1. Turn the unit **Off**.
2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
