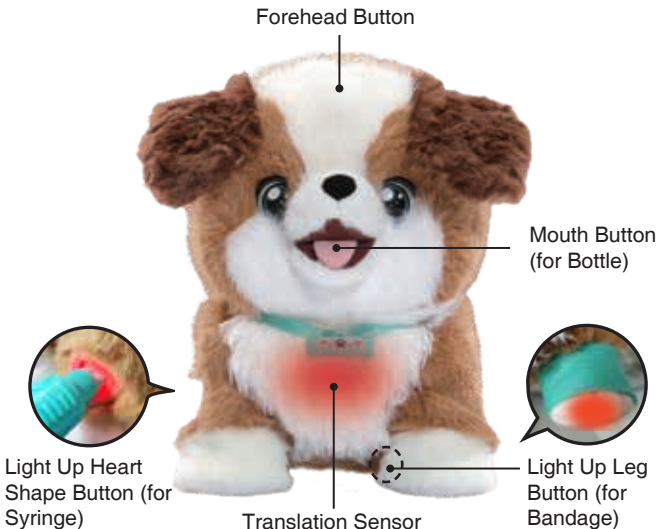

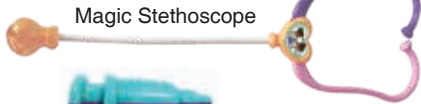
INTRODUCTION

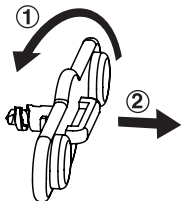

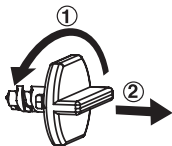
Unlock the Packaging Locks:



① Turn the packaging locks anticlockwise several times.

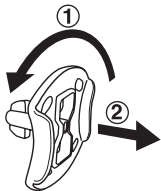
② Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

① Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise.

② Pull out the packaging locks and discard.

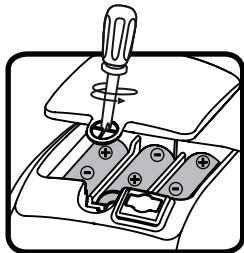
GETTING STARTED

Exit Try-Me

When you play with the Puppy for the first time, turn the unit **OFF** ● first, then slide the switch from **OFF** to the **Low Volume** (🔊) or **High Volume** (🔊) position to exit Try-Me mode. You can then press any button to start playing.

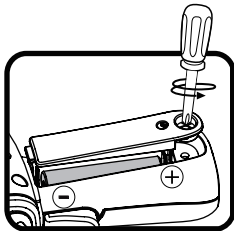
Battery Installation (Puppy)

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
4. Install 3 new AA (LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



Battery Installation (Thermometer)

1. Make sure the unit is turned **Off**.
2. Locate the battery cover on the side of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
3. Remove the old battery by lifting one end of the battery.
4. Install 1 new AA (LR6) battery (alkaline batteries



are recommended for best performance), following the diagram in the Battery Compartment.

5. Replace the Battery Compartment cover and tighten the screw to secure it.

WARNING:

Adult assembly is required. Batteries are included and must be installed by an adult before the toy is given to a child. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheellie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.



The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.

Please dispose of your product and batteries responsibly.

Product Features

1. OFF/LOW/HIGH VOLUME SWITCH

Locate this switch on the bottom of the unit.

To turn the unit **ON**, slide the switch from **OFF** to the **Low Volume** or **High Volume** position.

To turn the unit **OFF**, slide the switch to the **OFF** position.

To adjust the volume, slide the switch between the **Low Volume** and **High Volume** positions.



2. Motion

Puppy's ears flap and head nods.

NOTE: Do not forcibly stop this motion as it may damage or break the puppy.



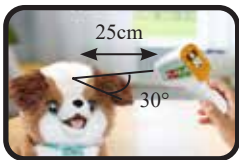
3. Magic Stethoscope

The **Magic Stethoscope** translates puppy's sounds into human voice. At any time during play, simply place the Magic Stethoscope on puppy's chest where the flashing light shows you to hear what puppy is saying.



4. Thermometer

Use the **Thermometer** to see how puppy is feeling. Press the button on the **Thermometer**, and the light will turn red or green. The green light indicates that the puppy is healthy, while a red light means the puppy requires care. A yellow light indicates that no puppy has been detected.



NOTE: For best results, point the **Thermometer** at the puppy's forehead within a 30° angle and from up to 25 cm away. The **Thermometer** works only when the puppy wakes up and will not function on other objects.

5. Forehead Button

Touch puppy's forehead to wake it up or to hear sound responses.



6. Light Up Heart Shape Button (for Syringe)

Use the **Syringe** to give the puppy an injection on the **Heart Shape Button**.



7. Mouth Button (for Bottle)

Feed the puppy by pressing the **Bottle** to its **Mouth Button**.



8. Light Up Leg Button (for Bandage)

When puppy's leg is injured, place the **Bandage** on its leg.



9. Carrier

The **Carrier** can be used to carry the puppy around.



10. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the puppy will automatically power down after several minutes without input. The puppy can be woken up again by pressing any buttons on the puppy.

NOTE: Puppy's chest will quick flash three times and power down when the puppy's battery level is low. If the puppy powers down while playing, we suggest replacing with a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

For the best light effect, it is recommended to play with this toy out of direct sunlight.

Puppy will express different moods depending on how you care for it. Sometimes the puppy will be happy and want to interact with you, while other times the puppy may need your care. In each situation, you can help the puppy by using the different accessories it requests. At any time during play, place the Magic Stethoscope on puppy's chest to hear what the puppy is saying in a human voice.

1. My Favourite

Puppy likes to share its favourite things with you, including its feelings, favourite colours, and favourite foods.

2. Caring and Health Check

Care for the puppy by feeding it, giving it its water bottle, and performing regular health checks. Use the Magic Stethoscope to listen to its wants and needs.

3. Temperature

When Puppy has a fever, use the Thermometer to check its temperature. Then give the puppy some water to help it cool down or use the Syringe to give it medicine. After this treatment, the puppy will recover and feel better.

4. Injured Paw

When puppy's paw is injured, gently place the Bandage on its paw. After the treatment, the puppy will recover and feel better.

5. Allergy

If the puppy has an allergy, use the Syringe to give it medicine. After the treatment, the puppy will feel better.

6. Leg Pain

When puppy's leg gets hurt, use the Syringe to give it medicine. After the treatment, the puppy feels better.

7. Tired

When the puppy is tired, gently pat the Forehead Button to help it relax.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and heat source.
3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
