

Start the engine and take a trip with the **VTech[®] Playtime Bus™** with Phonics! Through interactive play, your child can learn phonic sounds, letters, vocabulary, numbers, counting and safety rules. The bus also features lots of melodies, sing-along songs and fun, realistic bus sound effects! Learning has never been so much fun!

WARNING:

All packing materials, such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks and tags are not part of this toy, and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE: Please keep instruction manual as it contains important information.

Unlock the packaging locks:



- Rotate the packaging lock counter-clockwise 90 degrees.
- 2 Pull out the packaging lock.

Demo strip removal:

When the product is taken out of the packaging, please remove the demo strip next to the battery cover to activate the normal play mode.

GETTING STARTED BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is OFF.
- Locate the battery cover on the bottom of the unit.
- 3. Use a screwdriver or coin to open the cover.
- Install 2 new "AA" batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new, alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)



5. Replace the battery cover and tighten to secure.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH

Slide the OFF/VOLUME CONTROL SWITCH to the HIGH Volume or the LOW Volume position to turn the unit on or adjust the volume.

2. MODE SELECTOR

Slide the MODE SELECTOR to choose a game to play.

3. CHARACTER BUTTONS

Press a CHARACTER BUTTON to learn safety rules or fun phrases.

4. NUMBER BUTTONS

Press the NUMBER BUTTONS to learn numbers, answer the questions in the Challenge Time activity or compose music in the Music Station activity.

5. LETTER BUTTONS

Press the LETTER BUTTONS to learn phonic sounds, letter names, vocabulary, hear fun sounds or answer the guestions in the Challenge Time activity.











6. DOOR

Open the **DOOR** to count how many children get on or off the bus, or shut the **DOOR** to continue your trip.

7. GO BUTTON

Press the **GO BUTTON** to hear the fun sing-along song and see where you will go on the **ROTATING DESTINATION BOARD**.

8. HORN BUTTON

Press the HORN BUTTON to hear the bus horn.

9. START BUTTON

Press the **START BUTTON** to hear the bus engine sound.

10. BRAKE BUTTON

Press the **BRAKE BUTTON** to hear the bus brake.











11. MOVING WHEELS

Push the bus for rolling fun and musical play.

12. FLASHING HEADLIGHTS

The **FLASHING HEADLIGHTS** flash when a voice or melody is played.

13. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life, the **VTech[®] Playtime Bus™ with Phonics** will automatically power-down after several minutes without input or after around 20 minutes of continuous pushing of the bus. The unit can be reactivated by pressing any button or sliding the Mode Selector.

ACTIVITIES

1. Phonics Explore

Press any **LETTER BUTTON** to learn the phonic sound, letter name, fun vocabulary and to hear some fun sounds.

2. Number Fun

Time to learn our numbers! Press any **NUMBER BUTTON** to learn that number and number order.

3. Challenge Time

Questions about letters and numbers will be asked to reinforce the learning.

4. Music Station

Press a **LETTER BUTTON** to hear different melodies, or press a **NUMBER BUTTON** to hear a music note or to create your own song.

- 1. Ride, ride, ride the bus Happily to school There's ABCs and 123s Learning is so cool!
- Ride, ride, ride the bus To the park we ride We'll run and jump and climb so high And then go down the slide!

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING


If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please:

- 1. Turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, replace with a new set of batteries.
