

2 Pull out the packaging lock.


GETTING STARTED

BATTERY INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is OFF.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit.
- Install 2 new "AA" Size (AM3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (The use of new alkaline batteries is recommended for maximum performance.)
- 4. Replace the battery cover.

BATTERY NOTICE

- Use new alkaline batteries for maximum performance.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH), or new and used batteries.
- Do not use damaged batteries.





- Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. ON/OFF BUTTON

Press the ON/OFF BUTTON to turn the unit ON and press it again to turn the unit **OFF**.

2. MUSIC BUTTON

Press the MUSIC BUTTON to hear fun melodies and watch Tom and his friends dance.

3. SETTINGS BUTTON

Press the SETTINGS BUTTON to adjust the screen contrast and volume or to turn the background music on or off. Use the up and down ARROW BUTTONS to select which item to adjust then press the left and right ARROW BUTTONS to make adjustments. Press the **OK BUTTON** to return to the main menu.

4. MODE BUTTONS



Press one of the three MODE BUTTONS to choose activities in LANGUAGE MODE, MATHS MODE or LOGIC MODE.

5. HOLOPAX BUTTON



Press the HOLOPAX BUTTON to play a shadow match game.

6. OK BUTTON



Press the OK BUTTON to confirm your choice.

7. 4 ARROW BUTTONS

Press the ARROW BUTTONS to move or to make a selection in a menu or activity.



8. LETTER BUTTONS

Press the LETTER BUTTONS to learn letters or to answer letter related questions.



9. NUMBER BUTTONS

Press the **NUMBER BUTTONS** to learn numbers or to answer number related questions.



10. HELP BUTTON

Press the HELP BUTTON to hear an instruction or question repeated.

11. AUTOMATIC SHUT-OFF

To preserve battery life the unit will automatically turn off after several minutes without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing the **ON/OFF BUTTON**.

The unit will also automatically turn off when the batteries are very low. A warning will be displayed on the screen as a reminder to change the batteries.

ACTIVITIES

The **VTech® Tree Fu Tom Learn & Go** offers a total of 8 fun activities to play.

LANGUAGE MODE

1. Letters & Words

Explore and learn in Treetopolis with Treetog. Press the LETTER BUTTONS to learn letters & words.

2. Letter Tunnels

MATHS MODE

Help Squirmtum choose the correct tunnels to find his friends. Press a LETTER BUTTON or use the ARROW BUTTONS to choose then press OK to answer. After three correct answers a character will be found.

1. Sap Day Bun Counting

Count how many sap day buns Rickety has made then press a **NUMBER BUTTON** to answer.

2. Chuckleberry Sorting

Help Ariela sort the chuckleberries. Use the **ARROW BUTTONS** to choose then press **OK** to answer.













LOGIC MODE



1. Nectar Collection

Help Twigs collect the nectar. Use the ARROW BUTTONS to move the bowl left and right to collect the drops of nectar. See how much you can collect!

2. Big World Magic

Tom needs your help to save the day. Remember the moves he makes then use the ARROW BUTTONS to repeat them. There are 4 levels in this game. Level 1 = 1 move, level 2 = 2 moves, level 3 = 3 moves and level 4 = 4 moves. Level up after 3 correct answers.





MUSIC TIME




It's music time! Join Tom and his friends for a dance! Press a NUMBER BUTTON or use the ARROW BUTTONS to choose then press OK to pick a melody.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to excess moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, then please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit OFF.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit back ON. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, replace with an entire set of new batteries.
