WARNING:

All packing materials such as tape, plastic sheets, packaging locks, removable tags, cable ties and packaging screws are not part of this toy and should be discarded for your child's safety.

NOTE: Please keep this Parent's Guide as it contains important information.

Unlock the Packaging Lock



- Rotate the packaging lock anticlockwise 90 degrees.
- ② Pull out the packaging lock and discard.

WARNING!

Not to be used by children over 36 months. Insufficient strength. Protective equipment should be worn. 20kg Max. Regularly check for signs of wear or tear on the snap in or locking devices. If damaged do not use until repaired or replaced. Only to be used under the direct supervision of a competent adult.

- This toy should be used in a safe area e.g indoors, in a private garden, on level flat surfaces and away from any hazards such as cars, stairs, water etc.
- Not for use on pavements or in traffic.
- Adult supervision is advised.
- Please help your child to sit properly on the seat and to use the toy correctly.
- Since skill is required this toy should be used with caution to avoid falls or collisions that could cause injury to the user or third parties.

WARNING! Protective equipment should be worn. Not to be used in traffic. 20kg Max. Please wear helmet, gloves, knee pads and elbow pads.

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the bottom of the interactive dashboard and use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AA (LR6/AM-3) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box.
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- Do not mix different types of batteries: alkaline, standard (carbonzinc) or rechargeable, or new and used batteries.
- · Do not use damaged batteries.
- · Insert batteries with the correct polarity.
- · Do not short-circuit the battery terminals.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging (if removable).



 Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in Battery Directive (2006/66/EC).



Three Ways to Play and Ride

Use the back handle as a grip for little ones learning to walk. Progress to a three-wheeled motorbike and then to a two-wheeler when they are ready to balance.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the **3-in-1 Ride with Me Motorbike**, safety comes first. Adult assembly required. For your child's safety, do not let them play with this toy until it is fully assembled.

 To assemble the front wheel, insert the wheel into the slot on the bottom of the vehicle body. You will hear the pieces snap together when connected properly.



Insert the Interactive Dashboard into the slot on the top of the vehicle body. You will hear the pieces snap together when connected properly.



 To assemble the back wheels in the tricycle position, insert each of the wheels into the slots on the bottom of the vehicle body so the tricycle labels are visible. You will hear the pieces snap together when connected properly.



4. To assemble the back wheels in the motorbike position, insert each of the wheels into the slots on the bottom of the vehicle body so the motorbike labels are visible. You will hear the pieces snap together when connected properly.



5. To use the motorbike as a push-along walker with the wheels in tricycle position, slide the Locking Switch to the locked position so the front wheel does not turn left or right, providing a more stable walker. When using the motorbike as a ride-on toy, slide the Locking Switch to the unlocked position.



To remove the back wheels, slide the wheel locks inwards to unlock the wheels.



Insert the back handle into the two slots on the back of vehicle body. You will hear the pieces snap together when connected properly.



Insert the storage basket into the slot between the back handle as illustrated.




Once you've completed the above steps, you are ready to play!

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Selector

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/ Volume Selector** to the Low volume **1)** or the High volume **1)** position. You will hear a sound and a phrase. To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/Volume Selector** to the **Off** ● position.



2. Activity Selector

Turn the **Activity Selector** to choose a mode of play. The three modes of play include Learning mode, Adventure mode and Music mode.



3. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **3-in-1 Ride with Me Motorbike** will automatically shut off after several minutes without input. The unit can be turned on again by adjusting the **Activity Selector** or sliding the **On/Off/Volume Selector** or turning the **Ignition Switch**.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Community Buttons

Press the **Community Buttons** to learn about colours and locations around town in Learning mode. In Adventure mode you will hear a variety of phrases to encourage imaginative play. In Music mode you will hear songs. The lights will flash with the sounds.



2. Ignition Switch

Turn the **Ignition Switch** to hear realistic engine sounds and imaginative phrases. The lights will flash with the sounds.



3. Arrow Buttons

Press the **Arrow Buttons** to learn about colours and hear interactive phrases and melodies. The lights will flash with the sounds.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
